Keynote Speaker, Deanna Hynes, is a fierce advocate for survivors of child sexual abuse and a national public speaker with Childhood Victories. She has presented to over 250,000 individuals. She is a survivor of child sexual assault at the hands of her biological father. She is a mother, wife and make-up enthusiast.

Deanna will be speaking about the impact of the abuse on her life, including disclosing the abuse to her mother who did not support her at the age of 13 and then later disclosing to her husband at age 20. She will share her journey from the time of her disclosure until she became a public speaker, about her decision to press charges against her father and of the tough legal process to get some sense of justice.
