As Director of Program Management at NASHIA, she oversees membership and product implementation, including the Online Brain Injury Screening and Support System (OBISSS).

Her career highlights include serving as a TBI Care Coordinator for the Alabama Department of Rehabilitation Services, a vocational evaluator for Easter Seals, and a forensic rehabilitation professional. She has also contributed as an adjunct instructor at both Alabama State and Auburn Universities.
